


To what extent do you agree or disagree with the following statement:

"Through my time in education so far, I've learnt…" (What we can do at local and global levels to lessen climate change)




To what extent do you agree or disagree with the following statement:

"Through my time in education so far, I've learnt…" (What our daily lives will look like as a result of climate change)




