

Green Impact Auditor: Volunteer Role Profile

Overview

The University of Worcester and SOS UK are offering students the opportunity to gain new skills and knowledge by conducting Green Impact audits, a sustainability awards programme that has run in over 300 organisations worldwide.

Green Impact aims to celebrate and recognise sustainability achievements whilst also providing a framework to improve the university's sustainability performance.

Teams of staff and students across the university have been working on a variety of projects to support a more sustainable Worcester. As a Green Impact auditor, you will assess teams' progress and provide feedback. Following the audit, all participating teams will be awarded a Bronze, Silver, Gold or Platinum award based on the audit results.

Commitment

- Attend ISEP- approved training on the 6th of May (2.5 hrs);
- Conduct at least one audit of a Green Impact team (usually the afternoon after the training);
- **This is a voluntary post** with great opportunities for professional and personal development.

What will you be doing?

Your role will be to conduct one or more audits of a team's Green Impact activities (via Teams) and verify that they have completed everything they have told us they have. You will receive a case study and project plan for each team, which will help you understand what they have done on their project. You will need to read through this and plan any additional questions you may have for the team during the audit.

You will also be asked to provide some feedback on what they did well and where they could improve, and report back to the Green Impact team with your overall feedback.

- Develop your understanding of what is happening on sustainability across the University of Worcester;

Key competencies desired

- Ability to use own initiative;
